Applications are invited from eligible practicing advocates, who are not less than 35 years and not more than 45 years (in case of General candidates) or 48 years of age (in case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates) having not less than 7 years of practice as an Advocate in the courts of Civil and Criminal jurisdiction as on the last date from the date of publication of this advertisement, for filling up of 1 (one) vacant post (unreserved) in Grade-I cadre of the Nagaland Judicial Service in the pay scale of Rs. 51550-1230-58930-63070/- per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules. The post advertised is provisional as the cadre strength in Nagaland Judicial Service has not yet been finalised.
- 2. Detail scrutiny of the applications will be made after the declaration of the result of the written examination. Hence, the candidature of the applicants will be provisional and subject to furnishing of true and correct information against the fields indicated in the application form and fulfilment of the criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
- 3. A candidate must be a citizen of India as defined in Articles 5 & 6 of the Constitution of India and must be a holder of Degree in Law from a recognized University.

- 10. The candidates shall have to appear in a written examination and interview as per the following syllabus:

<u>Paper-I</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three) hours duration to test the General knowledge, aptitude, intelligence, test of comprehension and expression of law and General English including Essay writing on legal topic and information technology.

<u>Paper-II</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three)hours duration regarding objective questions and problems of law as regards the Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act.

<u>Paper-III</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three) hours duration consisting of Judgment writing (Paper book to be supplied) - Legal theories on jurisprudence, provision of Constitution of India.

Note: The candidate is expected to refer to the relevant decisions of the Apex Court and the High Court while writing answers in Papers II and III.

- 11. General candidates who obtain 60% or more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce. Other candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes who obtain 50% or more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce subject to a ratio of 1:3 from amongst the successful candidates in the written examination.
- 12. In the viva-voce out of 50 marks, the candidates will have to secure 60% or more marks. The final selection will be made subject to overall suitability.

- 13. The written examination/viva voce and all other conditions for appointment shall be as per the Rules. The candidates shall have to appear in the written examination/viva voce at their own expense, as and when called for.
