- (1) Online applications are invited from practising Advocates who are not less than 35 years and not more than 45 years of age (in case of General Candidates) and 48 years of age (in case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates) as on the fifteenth day from the date of publication of this advertisement and having not less than 7 years of practice as an Advocate in the Courts of Civil and Criminal jurisdiction as on the fifteenth day from the date of publication of this advertisement, for appointment in **21 (twenty one)** vacant posts (Actual and Anticipated) in **Grade-I of the Assam Judicial Service** in the scale of pay of Rs.51550-1230-58930-1380-63070/ per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules (approximate total monthly emolument will be Rs.78847/-), so as to reach the undersigned on or before fifteen days from the date of publication of this advertisement.
- (2) No applications will be accepted after the closing date.
- (3) Detail scrutiny of the application will be made after the declaration of the result of the final written examination. Hence the candidature of the applicants will be subject to furnishing true & correct information against the fields indicated in the online application form and fulfilment of the criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
- (4) A candidate must be a citizen of India as defined in Articles 5 & 6 of the Constitution of India and must be a holder of Degree in Law of a recognized University.
- (5) The candidates shall have to appear in a Preliminary Examination (Screening test) of objective questions of 100 marks out of which 90 marks will cover General knowledge, Aptitude, intelligence, Test of Comprehension and expression of Law, English, Constitution of India, Code of Civil Procedure, Code of Criminal Procedure, Transfer of Property Act, Limitation Act, Indian Penal Code, Evidence Act, Legal Theories of Jurisprudence, Arbitration & Conciliation Act, Indian Contract Act, Family Law, Specific Relief Act, Motor Vehicle Act, Industrial & Labour Law, Land Acquisition Act, Law Relating to Trust, Indian Registration Act, Court Fees Act and remaining 10 marks to test the proficiency in Official Language(s) of the state of Assam and those candidates who will secure 60% or more marks in the Preliminary Examination (screening test) shall be eligible for appearing in the Final written examination. For the Final written examination 10 candidates will be called against 1 vacancy (1:10). Successful candidates in the Final written examination shall be called for Interview/Viva Voce.
- (6) All candidates who obtain 60 (sixty) percent or more aggregate marks in the Final Written Examination subject to securing 45 percent marks in individual papers I, II & III and minimum 35% marks in the language paper shall be eligible for Interview/Viva-Voce. Provided that Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe candidates who obtain 50 (fifty) percent or more aggregate marks subject to obtaining 40 percent marks in individual paper I, II & III and minimum 35%

marks in the language paper shall be eligible for Interview/Viva-Voce. This would be subject to the ratio of 1:3. In the Viva-Voce out of 50 marks the candidates will have to secure minimum 60% marks. The final selection shall be made subject to overall suitability.

- (7) The candidates shall have to appear in the written test / examination and interview at their own expenses as and when called for.
- (8) Numbers of posts advertised include anticipated vacancies also and therefore, the actual vacancy position may vary. Mere selection would not *per se* entitle a candidate to claim appointment.
- (9) A fresh recruit joining the service shall not be governed by the existing Assam Services (Pension) Rules, 1969 and orders issued there under from time to time. Their pension and other retirement benefit will be governed by "the new defined contributory Pension Scheme" of Government of Assam.
