- iv. CR dossiers containing CRs for the last ten years. In case of photocopies of CR dossiers, every page should be duly attested by an officer not below the rank of Under Secretary to the Govt. of India.

Application received after the closing date or without the APAR/CRs dossier (or attested photocopies of ACRs) or otherwise found incomplete or not in the prescribed proforma are liable to be rejected. Officers who apply for the post will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature subsequently. Advance copies of application received after the last date or otherwise found incomplete are liable to be rejected.

CHAPTER II PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS REGULATORY BOARD

3. Establishment and incorporation of the Board :-

- (1) With effect from such date as the Central Government may, by notification, appoint, there shall be established, for the purposes of this Act, a Board to be called the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board.
- (2) The Board shall be a body corporate by the name aforesaid, having perpetual succession and a common seal, with power, subject to the provisions of this Act, to acquire, hold and dispose of property, both movable and immovable, and to contract, and shall, by the said name, issue or be issued.
- (3) The Board shall consist of a Chairperson, a Member (Legal) and three other members to be appointed by the Central Government.
- (4) The head office of the Board shall be at New Delhi and regional offices at such places as the Board may deem necessary having regard to public interest and magnitude of the work.

4. Qualifications for appointment of Chairperson and other members :-

- (1) The Central Government shall appoint the Chairperson and other members of the Board from amongst persons of eminence in the fields of petroleum and natural gas industry, management, finance, law, administration or consumer affairs : Provided that no person shall be appointed as Member (Legal) unless he-

- (a) is qualified to be a Judge of a High Court; or
- (b) has been a member of the Indian Legal Service and has held a post in Grade I of that Service for at least three years.

- (2) The Central Government shall, for the purposes of selecting the Chairperson and after members of the Board and for preparing a panel of persons to be considered for appointment as the Technical Member (Petroleum and Natural Gas) of the Appellate Tribunal, constitute a Search Committee consisting of-

- (i) Member, Planning Commission in charge of the energy sector - Chairperson;
- (ii) Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas - Member;
- (iii) Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Economic Affairs - Member;
