- 7. The candidates shall have to appear in a **written examination** consisting of the following papers:
 - a. <u>Paper-I</u>: One paper of 100 marks (duration not less than 2 hours) to test the General knowledge, aptitude, intelligence, test of comprehension and expression of law and General English including Essay writing on legal topic and information technology.
 - b. <u>Paper-II</u>: One paper of 100 marks of not less than 2 hours duration regarding objective questions and problems of law as regards the Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act.
 - c. <u>Paper-III</u>: One paper of 100 marks (duration not less than 2 hours) consisting of Judgment writing (Paper book to be supplied) Legal theories on jurisprudence, provision of Constitution of India.

Note: The candidate is expected to refer to the relevant decisions of the Apex Court and the High Court while writing answers in Papers II and III.

- 8. All the candidates who clear the written examination shall be called for the **Viva-Voce** Examination of 50 marks. Candidates belonging to the Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribes, who obtain 50% or more marks in the written examination, shall be eligible for viva-voce. Other candidates who obtain 60% or more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce.
- 9. The written test/viva voce test and all other conditions for appointment shall be as per the Arunachal Pradesh Judicial Service Rules, 2006. The candidates shall have to appear in the written test/viva voce examination at their own expense, as and when called for.
- 10. The number of posts advertised is existing vacancies only. Mere selection would not per se entitle a candidate to claim appointment.
