- 1. Applications in prescribed form are invited till 5.00 PM of 3-9-2015 from Advocates, who (a) Must be holder of degree in law of a recognized University, (b) Must be practicing as an advocate in Courts of Civil and Criminal jurisdiction on the last date fixed for receipt of applications and must have so practiced for a period of not less than seven years as on such date and (c) Must have attained the age of thirty five years and must not have attained the age of forty eight years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and forty five years in the case of others, as on the last date fixed for receipt of applications, for preparation of a list of selected candidates as well as for preparation of an additional list for filling up of 1(One) vacancy in Grade-I of Nagaland Judicial Service in the pay scale of Rs. 51,550-1230-58,930-63,070/- per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules. The vacancy postion is indicative only and may vary at the time of final selection.
- 2. 80% of the posts to be filled up by direct recruitment are reserved for the Naga Tribes namely Kuki, Garo, Kachari, Mikir or Any other, provided such persons are indigenous inhabitants of the State of Nagaland. Out of the 80% reserved posts, 25% shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the following 6 (six) Tribes of four districts of Mon, Tuensang, Kiphire and Longleng: (Category I).
  - i. Konyak
  - ii. Phom
  - iii. Sangtam
  - iv. Yimchunger
  - v. Chang
  - vi. Khiamniungan

Further, 12% posts out of the aforesaid 80% will be reserved for the following Tribes in the proportion indicated below: (Category II).

Chakhesang/Pochury

: 6%

ii. Zeliang

: 4%

iii. Sumis of Kiphire District

: 2%

3. No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service (a) unless he is a citizen of india; (b) if he has been dismissed from service by any High Court, Government or statutory or local authority; (c) if he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or who is or has

been permanently debarred or disqualified by the High Court or the Union Public Service Commission or any State Public Service Commission from appearing in any examination or selection conducted by it; (d) if he directly or indirectly influences the recruiting authority by any means for his candidature and (e) if he/she has more than one spouse living.

- 4. The policy of reservation would be as per the Nagaland Judicial Service Rules, 2006 (as amended).
- 5. The duly filled in application form in the prescribed format along with all documents should reach The Registrar, The Gauhati High Court, Kohima Bench, Kohima, Nagaland, PIN-797001. The envelope containing the application form and documents should be superscribed as "Application for direct recruitment to Grade-I of NJS, 2015".
- 6. Self Attested copies of documents in proof of his/her educational qualifications, Bar Council's Registration, Age and Certificate of Practice, Caste Certificate etc. along with 4 (Four) copies of recent passport size photograph should be submitted along with the Application Form.
- 7. The envelope containing the application form and documents should be dropped in the Drop Box kept in The Gauhati High Court, Kohima Bench, Kohima, Nagaland during office hours. No applications will be received after the last date fixed for receipt of application forms.
- 8. No fee is required for submission of application forms.
- 9. The candidates will have to appear in a Preliminary Examination (Objective type multiple choices) of 100 marks (2 hours duration) which will cover General knowledge, Aptitude, Intelligence, Test of Comprehension and expression of Law, General English and information technology, Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act, Legal Theories on Jurisprudence and provision of Constitution of India. From the rank wise list of marks of the Preliminary Examination (Objective type multiple choices), 10 (Ten) candidates will be called against 1(One) vacancy in the ratio of 1:10 for the Main Written Examination.
- 10. All candidates who obtain 60 (sixty) percent or more marks or corresponding grade in the Main Written Examination shall be eligible for Viva-Voce of 50 (Fifty) marks. Provided that Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates who obtain 50 (fifty) percent or more marks or corresponding grade in the Main Written Examination shall be eligible for Viva-Voce. This would be subject to the ratio of 1:3 of the rank wise list of marks obtained by the candidates in the Main Written Examination. In the Viva-Voce, out of 50(Fifty) marks the candidates will have to secure minimum 60% marks. However, final selection shall be made subject to overall suitability to be decided by the Gauhati High Court.
- 11. The Written Examinations/viva voce and all other conditions for appointment shall be as per the Nagaland Judicial Service Rules, 2006, as amended. The candidates shall have to appear in the Written Examinations/viva voce at their own expenses, as and when called for.

- 12. Mere inclusion of the name of a candidate in the select list or additional list shall not confer on the candidate any right of appointment.
- 13. Detail syllabus for the Written Examinations/viva-voce is annexed with this advertisement.
- 14. All other matters which are not specifically provided in this advertisement shall be as decided by the Gauhati High Court.

### Preliminary Examination (Objective type multiple choices)

General knowledge, Aptitude, Intelligence, Test of Comprehension and expression of Law, General English and information technology, Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act, Legal Theories on Jurisprudence and provision of Constitution of India.

#### **Main Written Examination**

- a. <u>Paper-I</u>: One paper of 100 marks (duration not less than 2 hours) to test the General Knowledge, aptitude, intelligence, test of comprehension and expression of law and General English including essay writing on legal topic and information technology.
- b. <u>Paper-II</u>: One paper of 100 marks (duration not less than 2 hours) regarding objective questions and problems of law as regards the Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code and Limitation Act.
- c. <u>Paper-III</u>: One paper of 100 marks (duration not less than 2 hours) consisting of Judgment writing (Paper book to be supplied), Legal theories on Jurisprudence, Provision of Constitution of India.

(Note: The candidates are expected to refer to the relevant decisions of the Apex Court and the High Court while writing answers in Paper II and III)
