Applications are invited from eligible law graduates, who must not have completed, as on the last date for receipt of applications, 35 years (in case of General candidates) or 38 years of age (in case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates) for filling up of 3 (three) existing and 1 (one) anticipated vacant posts (provisional) in Grade-III cadre of the Nagaland Judicial Service in the pay scale of Rs. 27,700-770-33,090-920-40,450-1080-44,770 per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules. The aforesaid vacancy position may vary at the time of preparation of final select list.
- 2. The duly filled-in application should reach the undersigned on or before the fifteenth day from the date of publication of this advertisement.
- 3. Detail scrutiny of the applications will be made after the declaration of the result of the written examination. Hence, the candidature of the applicants will be provisional and subject to furnishing of true and correct information against the fields indicated in the application form and fulfilment of the criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
- 4. A candidate must be a citizen of India as defined in Articles 5 & 6 of the Constitution of India and must be a holder of Degree in Law from a recognized University.
- 5. 80% of the posts are reserved for the Naga Tribes namely Kuki, Garo, Kachari, Mikir or Any other, provided such persons are indigenous inhabitants of the State of Nagaland. - 12. All the candidates who clear the written examination shall be called for the Viva-voce Examination of 70 marks.
- 13. General candidates who obtain 60% or more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce. Other candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes who obtain 50% or more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce.
- 14. The selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the written examination & viva-voce. The final selection will be made subject to overall suitability.
- 15. The written examination/viva voce and all other conditions for appointment shall be as per the Rules. The candidates shall have to appear in the written examination/viva voce at their own expense, as and when called for.
- 16. A fresh recruit joining the service shall not be governed by the existing Nagaland Services (Pension) Rules, 1969 and orders issued there-under, from time to time. Their pension and other retirement benefits will be governed by "the new defined contributory Pension Scheme" of the Government of Nagaland.
