Subject: Control of National Highways (Land & Traffic) Act, 2002- Application for appointment as Presiding Officer of the National Highways Tribunal.

I am directed to say that under the "Control of National Highways(Land & Traffic)Act, 2002, a total of eight National Highways Tribunals have been set up at Bengaluru, Chandigarh, Chennai, Guwahati, Jabalpur, Kolkata, Lucknow and Mumbai. The Act provides for control of land within the National Highways, right of way and traffic moving on the National Highways and also for the removal of unauthorized occupation thereon. The objectives of the Act are to be achieved through the National Highway Administration established under Section 3 of the Act. The appeals against the orders passed by the Highway Administrations under Sections 26, 27, 28, 36, 37 and 38 shall lie before the National Highway Tribunal established under Section 5 of the Act. The Tribunal consists of only one person known as Presiding Officer in the Pay Band-4[Rs.37000-67000] with Grade Pay of Rs. 10000/- per month.

2. Under Section 7 of the Act, for appointment as the Presiding Officer, a person has to be qualified to be a Judge of a High Court or he should have been a Member of the Indian Legal Service and should have held a post not less than Grade-II [Rs.14,300-18,300/-(pre-revised) of that service. Here it is specifically mentioned that a person has for at least ten years been an advocate of a High Court or of two or more such courts in succession is also eligible. The appointment to the post of Presiding Officer at National Highways Tribunals will be governed by the National Highways Tribunal(Procedure for appointment as Presiding Officer of the Tribunal) Rules, 2003. The service conditions of the officers appointed as Presiding Officers of the National Highways Tribunals will be governed by the National Highways Tribunal(Salaries, Allowances and other condition of service of Presiding Officer) Rules, 2005. Under Rule 13 of the said Rules, a person who has completed 60 years of age before the appointment shall not be appointed as Presiding Officer of a Tribunal.

3. In accordance with the aforesaid Rules, it has now been decided to make a fresh panel of candidates to fill up the post of Presiding Officer in the National Highways Tribunal at Mumbai and also to fill up the vacancies existing as well arising from time to time against the posts of Presiding Officer in the remaining Tribunals as and when required.

4. It is, therefore, requested that this circular may be given wide publicity amongst the eligible persons/officers and the names of the suitable and wiling persons/officers may be sent to the Under Secretary (P&M), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Transport

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

I am directed to say that it is proposed to fill up the post of Professor of Law in the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie on deputation (including short-term contract)/absorption basis. Scale of pay, eligibility conditions i.e. qualifications and experience, period of deputation and duties etc. for the post are indicated below:

Method of recruitment : **Deputation (including short-term contract)/Absorption Basis**
Classification of the post : **General Central Service, Group 'A', Gazetted**

Eligibility

Officer of the Central Government or State Governments or Union territories or Public Sector Undertakings or Universities or Recognised Research Institutions or Autonomous or Semi-Government or Statutory Organisations :-

- a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
(ii) With two years' regular service in posts in the scale of 14300-18300 (pre-revised) or equivalent; or
(iii) With six years' regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 12000-18300 (pre-revised) or equivalent; or
(iv) With eleven years' regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 10000-15200 (pre-revised) or equivalent; and

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b) Possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed below:

Essential Qualifications

1(i) Master Degree in Law (LLM) from a recognised University or equivalent.
(ii) ten years' experience in imparting training or teaching or research in legal affairs or in administration or in judicial service or ten years' practical experience at Bar as an advocate of which three years should be in a High Court as a Senior Advocate.

Or

2. (i) Degree in Law (LL.B.) from a recognized University or equivalent;
(ii) twelve years' experience in a state judicial service out of which five years should be at the level of Additional District Judge and session judge or above.

Or

Twelve years' practical experience at the Bar of which five years should be in a High Court as a Senior Advocate. OR

Twelve years' experience in imparting training or teaching or research in legal affairs or in administration.

Note 1. Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2. The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC in the case of candidates belonging to the SC and ST, if at any stage of selection, the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.

DESIRABLE :

(i) Experience as District Judge and Sessions Judge; or
(ii) Doctorate Degree in Law from a recognized University or equivalent.

Note: Only officers belonging to Central Government/State Government/Union Territories are eligible for being considered for appointment on absorption.

Age Limit:

The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract)/ absorption shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications for all the above mentioned posts.

Period:

Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years for all the above mentioned posts.

Duties and responsibilities of the post include: Teaching, Training, Counselling, Preparation of Reading Material, Setting of Examination Paper, functions of Course Co-coordinator/Associate Course Coordinator etc.

The candidate selected to the post will be entitled to training allowance @ 30% of his basic pay in the parent department, in lieu of deputation allowance, if deputationist opts for the pay scale of his parent department.

It is requested to circulate the vacancy and forward the application of the officers who are willing and fulfill the eligibility criteria and can be spared immediately in the event of their selection to this Academy in the prescribed proforma as at Annexure-I, complete in all respects along with documents (cadre clearance, Integrity certificate, vigilance clearance, Major/Minor penalty imposed during the last ten years and up-to-date ACRs dossiers (or photocopy of ACRs for the last 5 years duly attested on each page by Gazetted Officer) **within 60 days** from the date of publication in the Employment News.
